



**THE ELECTRIC WATER-HEATING ORDER 1943,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939* and the Electricity Emergency Regulations 1939†, the Electricity Controller doth hereby order and direct as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Electric Water-heating Order 1943, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electric Water-heating Order 1943‡ (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. Clause 4 of the principal Order is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following new subclause:—

“(2) Subject to the exemptions provided for in clause 7 hereof—

“(a) Every supply authority shall as soon as practicable give notice in accordance with Regulation 8 of the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939, to the owner of every water-heating service for the operation of which electricity is supplied by the supply authority specifying the intention of the supply authority to install before the 31st day of March, 1945, in the premises in which the water-heating service is situated a meter for the measuring of the supply of electricity for the service, and every supply authority shall ensure that all such meters are installed and in operation by the said 31st day of March, 1945:

“(b) Any supply authority may, from time to time, in the case of a thermal storage water-heating service, give notice as aforesaid requiring the owner thereof before a date (being not earlier than twenty-one days after the giving of the notice) to be specified in the notice to alter the service so that the supply of electricity therefor is controlled by a thermostat. In specifying a date under this paragraph the supply authority shall have regard to the availability to the owner to whom the notice is given of the necessary labour, materials, and equipment, and of means of transportation of those materials and that equipment.”

3. Clause 4 of the principal order is hereby further amended by inserting in subclause (3), after the words “last preceding subclause”, the words “may be given by public notice or otherwise and”.
