THE ELECTRICAL WIRING REGULATIONS 1935,  
AMENDMENT NO. 8

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 8th day of June 1960

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the twenty-eighth day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 31-04, the following regulation:

“31-05. Every electrically heated blanket for domestic use manufactured for sale, or sold or offered for sale when unused, shall conform with the requirements of New Zealand standard specification No. 1302† and all amendments and consolidations thereof (whether made before or after the commencement of this regulation), or shall be of such other type as may from time to time be approved:

“Provided that until the 1st day of July 1961 any unused electrically heated blanket which conforms with the requirements of that standard specification as it was originally declared may be sold or offered for sale.”

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations require that electrically heated blankets for domestic use manufactured for sale, or sold or offered for sale when unused, shall conform with the requirements of New Zealand standard specification 1302 and all amendments and consolidations thereof, or shall be of some other approved type.

Unused blankets which comply with the requirements of the said standard specification as it was originally declared may be sold or offered for sale until 1 July 1961.
