**THE ELECTRICAL WIRING REGULATIONS 1961,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 11th day of October 1961

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in subclause (1), after the word "connected", the words "or intended to be connected".

3. Regulation 59 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the word "aluminium".

4. Table 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the heading thereto the words "Rubber-sheathed, P.V.C.-sheathed" where they first appear, and substituting the words "Rubber-insulated, P.V.C.-insulated".

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations extend the scope of the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961 so as to include wiring work on installations intended to be connected to a source of electricity. The restriction in regulation 59 on the use of single core aluminium-sheathed cables is removed because adequate control exists in the tables of the regulations dealing with current ratings of such cables.
