



**THE ELECTRICAL WIRING REGULATIONS 1961,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 30th day of June 1965

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to subclause 3 the following paragraph:

“(g) Any device or apparatus or material manufactured solely for export or imported solely for re-export.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide that any device or apparatus or material manufactured solely for export or imported solely for re-export shall be exempt from the provisions of the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1961.
