PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 26th day of June 1987.

2. Apparatus and materials submitted for opinion—Regulation 22 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “, and a fee of \$3.00 shall be payable for the inspection of each article submitted”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 26 June 1987, omit the requirement to pay a fee of \$3 when submitting any electrical apparatus or material to the Secretary of Energy for an opinion as to its compliance with the requirements of the principal regulations. The Secretary of Energy is empowered to fix a charge for such a submission pursuant to section 15BA of the Ministry of Energy Act 1977 (as enacted by the Ministry of Energy Amendment Act 1987).
