**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 14th day of  
July, 1943

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Electrical Wiremen's Registration Act, 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Electrical Wiremen's Registration Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Electrical Wiremen's Registration Regulations 1940\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following paragraph to clause (2) :—

“(d) Any work done upon or in connection with any conductor, apparatus, or device used or intended to be used—

“(i) In any mine which comes under the provisions of the Coal-mines Act, 1925, or the Mining Act, 1926 ; or

“(ii) In any building which is for the time being directly used for the working of such a mine, and under the direct control of the mine-manager.”
