## THE ELECTRICAL WIREMEN'S REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1940, AMENDMENT NO. 2

### Present:

THE HON, S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Electrical Wiremen's Registration Act, 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Electrical Wiremen's Registration Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electrical Wiremen's Registration Regulations 1940\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked, and the following regulation substituted therefor:—
- "REGULATION 11—TRAVELLING EXPENSES, ALLOWANCES AND FEES
  TO BOARD MEMBERS
- $^{\circ}$  (1) The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949† shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in this regulation so as to relate to the Board and its members.
- "(2) The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 5 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations, 1949† shall be at the rate of £1 15s. a day:
- "Provided that where a member is entitled to a subsistence allowance and occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional amount of 2s. may be paid to that member.
- "(3) The rate of mileage allowance referred to in Regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be calculated in accordance with the following table:—

Horse-power of Car.	Mileage Allowance.

"(4) Garage expenses payable to a member pursuant to this regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night on which any such

expenses are incurred.

"(5) The Board may pay to any member to whom allowances and travelling-expenses are payable pursuant to the said Act for each day he is travelling or occupied in connection with the business of the Board, a fee not exceeding £2 2s. for each such day or £2 2s. for each meeting.

"(6) The maximum fee which may be paid to any member for any one day shall not exceed £2 2s., notwithstanding that the member may have attended one or more meetings of the Board or of any

Committee of the Board on any such day."
