



**THE FISHERIES (1985-86 COMMERCIAL QUOTAS ALLOCATION)
NOTICE 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to regulation 5 of the Fisheries (1985-86 Commercial Quotas and Restrictions) Regulations 1986, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (1985-86 Commercial Quotas Allocation) Notice 1986, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (1985-86 Commercial Quotas Allocation) Notice 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—Clause 3 of the principal notice is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (a), the following paragraph:

“(aa) Auckland Combined Offshore Fisheries Ltd are referred to as ‘ACOF’.”.

3. Hoki quota allocated—(1) Part I of the Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from the heading the word “HOKI”;

(b) By omitting the item relating to hoki.

(2) The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by adding the following Part:

Where any company that is a member of SIDWF is also allocated quota under its own name, the quota allocated to the company under its own name shall be additional to any allocated to the company as a member of SIDWF.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice is made under regulation 5 of the Fisheries (1985-86 Commercial Quotas and Restrictions 1986 (S.R. 1986/97) which is authorised by section 89 (1)(g) of the Fisheries Act 1983.

The notice allocates hoki quotas following an increase of 60 000 in the hoki quota by the Fisheries (1985-86 Commercial Quotas and Restrictions) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 1 (S.R. 1986/143).

In addition to the quotas allocated to individual commercial fishermen as set out in the notice the unallocated quota is increased by 1900 tonnes (from 2539 tonnes to 4439 tonnes).
