

# THE FISHERIES (1985–86 COMMERCIAL QUOTAS AND RESTRICTIONS) REGULATIONS 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 1

# ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 14th day of July 1986

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (1985-86 Commercial Quotas and Restrictions) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (1985-86 Commercial Quotas and Restrictions) Regulations 1986\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Hoki quota increased—Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the 3rd column of the table, in relation to hoki, the expression "41,219", and substituting the expression "101,219".

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of these regulations is to increase the quota for hoki by 60,000 tonnes (from 41,219 tonnes to 101,219 tonnes). The allocation of the quota to specific commercial fishermen is a matter to be dealt with by Ministerial notice—see the Fisheries (Commercial Quotas Allocation) Notice 1986, Amendment No. 1 (S.R. 1986/147).
