THE FISHERIES (1986–87 COMMERCIAL QUOTAS ALLOCATION) NOTICE 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 2

PURSUANT to regulation 5 of the Fisheries (1986-87 Commercial Quotas) Regulations 1986, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (1986-87 Commercial Quotas Allocation) Notice 1986, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (1986-87 Commercial Quotas Allocation) Notice 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—(1) Clause 3 (2) of the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (g), and substituting the following paragraph:

"(g) Skeggs Foods 1987 Limited are referred to as 'Skeggs':".

(2) Clause 3 (2) of the principal notice is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (h), the following paragraph:

"(ha) United Fisheries Limited are referred to as 'United':".

3. Allocation of squid quota to specified commercial fishermen—The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this notice.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice relates to the allocation of squid quotas to commercial fishermen for squid taken by any method outside the Southern Islands Area. Of the total allowable catch of 21 823 tonnes, 18 949 tonnes has already been allocated, and under this notice a further 1558 tonnes is allocated.

The allocation to Skeggs is increased by 1183 tonnes from 1543 tonnes to 2726 tonnes.

A new allocation of 375 tonnes is made to United Fisheries Limited.

As the total allowable catch was increased by 1183 tonnes by the Fisheries (1986-87 Commercial Quotas) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 1 (S.R. 1987/110), the effect of these allocations on the unallocated quota available for competitive fishing is to reduce that unallocated quota by 375 tonnes, from 1691 tonnes to 1316 tonnes.

There is no change to the allocation of quota for the Southern Islands Area.
