

THE FISHERIES (1989–90 JACK MACKEREL QUOTA ALLOCATION) NOTICE 1989

PURSUANT to the Fisheries (1989-90 Jack Mackerel Quota) Regulations 1989, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title—This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (1989-90 Jack Mackerel Quota Allocation) Notice 1989.
- 2. Allocation of jack mackerel quotas—(1) The quota imposed by the Fisheries (1989-90 Jack Mackerel Quota) Regulations 1989 on the taking of jack mackerel in the Part Auckland (East), Central (East) Area is hereby allocated as set out in Part I of the Schedule to this notice.
- (2) The quota imposed by the Fisheries (1989-90 Jack Mackerel Quota) Regulations 1988 on the taking of jack mackerel in the South-East, Southland, Sub-Antarctic Area is hereby allocated as set out in Part II of the Schedule to this notice.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice is made under the Fisheries (1988-89 Jack Mackerel Quota) Regulations 1988. The notice allocates to individual commercial fishermen the quotas imposed by those regulations on the taking of jack mackerel by commercial fishermen, being—

- (a) 5970 greenweight tonnes for the Part Auckland (East), Central (East) Area:
- (b) 2700 greenweight tonnes for the South-East, Southland, Sub-Antarctic Area.

The unallocated portion of the quota for each area is as follows:-

- (a) 1155.6 greenweight tonnes for the Part Auckland (East), Central (East) Area:
- (b) 561.8 greenweight tonnes for the South-East, Southland, Sub-Antarctic Area.

The unallocated portion for each area may be taken by commercial fishermen who have not received any allocation of quota for the area or who have filled their allocations for the area.

The allocations in this notice are unchanged from those applying in the 1988-89 fishing year.
