## Schedule Amendment to Schedule 6 of Fisheries Act 1996

Stock	Area	Requirements
Knobbed whelk ( <i>Austrofusus glans</i> )	Quota management areas KWH1, KWH2, KWH3, KWH4, KWH5, KWH6, KWH7A, KWH7B, KWH8, and KWH9	A commercial fisher may return any knobbed whelk to the waters from which it was taken if— <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) the knobbed whelk is likely to survive on return; and</li> <li>(b) the return takes place as soon as practicable after the knobbed whelk is taken.</li> </ul>

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which takes effect on 1 October 2006, inserts knobbed whelk into Schedule 6 of the Fisheries Act 1996 as stocks that may be returned to the sea in accordance with certain requirements.
