THE FACTORIES ACT, 1946, MODIFICATION ORDER 1948

Pursuant to section 31 of the Factories Act, 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Factories Act, 1946, Modification Order 1948.
- 2. This Order shall come into force on the day following notification in the Gazette of the making thereof.
 - 3. This Order shall apply to the following class of factories:—
 New Zealand Government Railways Department factories.
- 4. With respect to the class of factories specified in clause 3 of this Order, the requirements of section 28 of the Factories Act, 1946, are hereby modified in the manner and to the extent following:—
 - Notwithstanding the requirements of subsection (1) of the said section 28, any person to whom that subsection applies may elect to receive no wages for a whole holiday allowed, and in lieu thereof to have a day off duty on pay at some subsequent date to be agreed upon between that person and his employer; and
 - Notwithstanding the requirements of subsection (5) of the said section 28, any person to whom that subsection applies may elect to receive in respect of work done on a whole holiday payment at double the ordinary rate only and no wages at the ordinary rate, and to have in lieu thereof a day off duty at the ordinary rate at some subsequent date to be agreed upon between that person and his employer.
