**2. Commencement of section 314 (1) (zo) and (3) of Fisheries Act 1996**—Section 314 (1) (zo) and (3) of the Fisheries Act 1996 comes into force on 1 December 1999.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force, on 1 December 1999, section 314 (1) (zo) and (3) of the Fisheries Act 1996.

Those provisions repeal Schedule 1E of the Fisheries Act 1983 (which specifies fisheries costs to be borne by the Crown) and revoke the Fisheries (Crown Contribution) Order 1995.
