PURSUANT to section 21 (3) of the Fisheries Amendment Act 1979, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Fisheries Amendment Act Commencement Order 1979.

2. Commencement of section 21 of Fisheries Amendment Act 1979—Section 21 of the Fisheries Amendment Act 1979 shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1980.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides that section 21 of the Fisheries Amendment Act 1979 (which relates to the repeal of provisions restricting dredging in the Foveaux Strait oyster fishery) is to come into force on 1 January 1980. The oyster fishery will be declared to be a controlled fishery on that date.
