

# THE FISHERIES (SOUTH-EAST AREA AMATEUR FISHING) REGULATIONS 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 5

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (South-East Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (South-East Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1994.
- 2. Maximum daily number of fish—Regulation 3A (1) of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (South-East Area

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1994, amend the Fisheries (South-East Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 by prescribing a daily amateur bag limit of 10 snapper in the South-East Fishery Management Area. The amateur bag limits for other species in the area remain the same.
