



**THE FISHERIES (CENTRAL AREA AMATEUR FISHING)
REGULATIONS 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 5**

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Central Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Central Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Set netting prohibited within defined area of coast adjacent to Cape Runaway—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 5A, the following regulation:

“5B. No person shall use any set net within those waters defined by a line beginning at the mean high-water mark at Pitikirua Point (at approximately $37^{\circ} 32.6'S$ and $178^{\circ} 4.8'E$); then proceeding in a straight line in a northerly direction to a position approximately 2 nautical miles from the point of commencement at $37^{\circ} 30.6'S$ and $178^{\circ} 4.8'E$; then in a generally westerly direction by a line every point of which is 2 nautical miles from the mean high-water mark to a point approximately 2 nautical miles north of Cape Runaway (at $37^{\circ} 30.3'S$ and $177^{\circ} 59'E$); then in a straight line in a southerly direction to the mean high-water mark at Cape Runaway (at approximately $37^{\circ} 32.3'S$ and $177^{\circ} 50'E$); and then proceeding along the line of the mean high-water mark in a generally easterly direction to the point of commencement at Pitikirua Point (at approximately $37^{\circ} 32.6'S$ and $178^{\circ} 4.8'E$).”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Fisheries (Central Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 to prohibit the use of set nets within 2 nautical miles of the shoreline to the east of Cape Runaway in the eastern Bay of Plenty.
