

# THE FISHERIES (SOUTH-EAST AREA AMATEUR FISHING) **REGULATIONS 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 7**

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (South-East Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (South-East Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Ngai Tahu eel fishery at Lake Forsyth—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 7, and substituting the following regulation:

"7. (1) No person who does not belong to the Ngai Tahu iwi shall take

any eels from Lake Forsyth.

"(2) For the purposes of this regulation the term 'Ngai Tahu iwi' means the collective of those individuals who descend from the primary hapu of Ngai Tahu and Ngai Mamoe, namely, Kati Kuri, Kati Irekehu, Kati Huirapa, Ngai Tuahuriri, and Kati Ruatikihiki."

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette, amend the Fisheries (South-East Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 to limit the right to take eels from Lake Forsyth to persons belonging to the Ngai Tahu iwi.
