



**FISHERIES AMENDMENT ACT (TRANSITIONAL LEVIES)
ORDER 1995**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 6 (5) of the Fisheries Amendment Act 1994, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries Amendment Act (Transitional Levies) Order 1995.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Compensation levy—Clause 4 of the Second Schedule to the Fisheries Amendment Act 1994 is hereby amended by omitting subclause (2), and substituting the following subclause:

“(2) The annual compensation levy shall be payable on demand made by the responsible chief executive in one or more instalments on such day or days as the responsible chief executive may specify”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends clause 4 of the Second Schedule to the Fisheries Amendment Act 1994 and relates to the compensation levy payable under that provision. The amendment is made under the authority of section 6 (5) of that Act and removes the requirement that the levy be paid on the instalment dates formerly fixed by clause 4 (2) and provides for the responsible chief executive to fix one or more such dates.
