PURSUANT to section 6(5) of the Fisheries Amendment Act 1994, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries Amendment Act (Transitional Levies) Order (No. 2) 1995.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- **2. Compensation levies reduced**—Part D of the Second Schedule to the Fisheries Amendment Act 1994 is hereby amended by omitting Parts I to III, and substituting the Parts set out in the Schedule to this order.
