THE FISHERIES (SOUTH-EAST AREA COMMERCIAL FISHING) REGULATIONS 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 11

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 11, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Interpretation—Regulation 2(1) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2(1) of the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 8) is hereby amended by inserting, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the following definitions:

"'Slender tuna' means a fish of the species Allothunnus fallai:

"'Rat tail' means a fish of the species Coelorhyncus biclinozonalis or a fish of the species Coelorhyncus aspercephalis:".

3. Targeting of certain fish, aquatic life, and seaweed prohibited, unless specially authorised—Regulation 11AA of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 8) is hereby amended by revoking subclause (5), and substituting the following subclause:

"(5) The species and classes of fish, aquatic life, and seaweed to which subclause (1) of this regulation applies are as follows:

"PROHIBITED TARGET SPECIES

2. Any other fish, aquatic life, or seaweed, not being-

- (a) Fish, aquatic life, or seaweed that is subject to a quota management system; or
- (b) Fish, aquatic life, or seaweed specified in regulation 11A or regulation 11AB of these regulations; or
- (c) Fish, aquatic life, or seaweed specified in Part A of this Table."

4. Species that may be taken subject to competitive or individual quotas, method restrictions, etc.—Regulation 11AB of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 8) is hereby amended by inserting in the Table, in its appropriate alphabetical order, the item "Slender tuna".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1992, amend the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986.

A new table of target species is substituted in regulation 11AA of the principal regulations, with the following changes:

- (a) Catseye, lamprey, limpet, mud crab, mud snail, New Zealand cancer crab, red rock crab, sea egg (other than kina), sea hare, sea slug, venerupis, and whelk are transferred from *Part A* (prohibited unless specially authorised) to *Part B* (totally prohibited):
- (b) Black shark, cardinal fish, ghost shark, and octopus are transferred from Part B to Part A. Rat tail is also included in Part A.

Regulation 11AB of the principal regulations is amended to include slender tuna in the table of species that may be taken from quota management area 3 or quota management area 4, subject to competitive or individual quotas, and method restrictions.
