## HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1988 and sections 297 and 298 of the Fisheries Act 1996, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 22, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Prohibition on trawling by large vessels in salmon conservation area adjacent to Banks Peninsula—Regulation 4B of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 21) is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3).

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986 by removing the 5-tonne salmon catch limit contained in regulation 4B (3) in relation to trawling by large vessels in the salmon conservation area adjacent to Banks Peninsula.
