Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Challenger Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Challenger Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Special concession for scallops taken from specified area in Tasman Bay—Regulation 12A (1) of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Fisheries (Challenger Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended by omitting from

paragraph (b) the expression "1st day of December", and substituting the expression "7th day of October".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect. The Fisheries (Challenger Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 4 amended the principal regulations to allow scallops of less than the normal 100 mm length to be taken from a deep water scallop bed situated in Outer Tasman Bay during a period between 21 August and 1 December 1988. These regulations limit that concession by providing for it to end on 7 October 1988.
