ORDER IN COUNCIL

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Set netting prohibited at southern end of Moeraki Peninsula—**

The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 3B (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 4), the following regulation:

“3c. No commercial fisherman shall use a set net in those waters lying within an area bounded by a line commencing at Tawhiroko Point at  $45^{\circ}22.3'S$  and  $170^{\circ}52.1'W$ , then proceeding on a bearing of  $045^{\circ}$  for 500 metres to a point at  $45^{\circ}22.1'S$  and  $170^{\circ}52.3'W$ , then in a southerly direction at a distance 500 metres from the mean high water mark to a point at  $45^{\circ}23.8'S$  and  $170^{\circ}51.6'W$ , then by a straight line to a point on the coast at  $45^{\circ}23.6'S$ ,  $170^{\circ}51.5'W$ , then generally in a southerly direction, and then in a northerly direction along the mean high water mark to the point of commencement.”

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986 to prohibit set netting at the southern end of the Moeraki Peninsula.
