

THE FISHERIES (SOUTH-EAST AREA COMMERCIAL FISHING) **REGULATIONS 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 6**

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Set netting prohibited at southern end of Moeraki Peninsula— The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 3B (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 4), the following regulation:

"3c. No commercial fisherman shall use a set net in those waters lying within an area bounded by a line commencing at Tawhiroko Point at 45°22.3'S and 170°52.1'W, then proceeding on a bearing of 045° for 500 metres to a point at 45°22.1'S and 170°52.3'W, then in a southerly direction at a distance 500 metres from the mean high water mark to a point at 45°23.8'S and 170°51.6'W, then by a straight line to a point on the coast at 45°23.6'S, 170°51.5'W, then generally in a southerly direction, and then in a northerly direction along the mean high water mark to the point of commencement."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Fisheries (South-East Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986 to prohibit set netting at the southern end of the Moeraki Peninsula.
