PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Central Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Central Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1994.

2. Interpretation—Regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Fisheries (Central Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 3) is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the term "dredge oyster", and substituting the following definition:

"'Dredge oyster' means a shellfish of the species "Tiostrea chilensis:".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1994, amend the Fisheries (Central Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986 by updating the definition of the term "dredge oyster" in regulation 2 of those regulations.
