PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Challenger Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Challenger Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Scallop season and quotas—(1) Regulation 12A of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (Challenger Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 8) is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) the expression “4,000”, and substituting the expression “5,000”.

(2) Regulation 3(c) of the Fisheries (Challenger Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 8 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Fisheries (Challenger Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986.

Regulation 2 amends regulation 12A of the principal regulations, which relates to the southern scallop season and quotas. The scallop limit per vessel is increased from 4,000 kilograms to 5,000 kilograms.
