PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983 and sections 297 and 298 of the Fisheries Act 1996, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Amendment Regulations 1997, and are part of the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986* (“the principal regulations”).

(2) These regulations come into force on 1 April 1997.

2. Removal of ban on taking oysters in Hauraki Gulf—

(1) Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the words “the Hauraki Gulf”.

(2) The Schedule of the principal regulations is amended by revoking item 1 (which relates to the Hauraki Gulf).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1997, amend the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 by removing the ban on the taking of oysters from the Hauraki Gulf by amateur fishers.
