HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Restrictions on fishing within 1 nautical mile of Mayor (Tuhua) Island—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 6A (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (Auckland and

Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following regulation:

“6A. No person shall use or possess for fishing a set net, or a line to which more than 3 hooks are attached, within 1 nautical mile seaward of the mean high-water mark of the coast of Mayor (Tuhua) Island.”

(2) Regulation 3 of the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 by providing that no person shall use a set net, or a line to which more than 3 hooks are attached, in the waters lying within 1 nautical mile of Mayor (Tuhua) Island.
