PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Maximum daily number of fish—Regulation 3A (3) of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 3) is

- **3. Minimum size for snapper**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 3B (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 3), the following regulation:
- "3c. Notwithstanding anything in regulation 6 of the Fisheries (Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986*, no person shall take any snapper from the Auckland and Kermadec Fishery Management Areas that is less than 27 cm in length or be in possession of any snapper taken from within those areas that is less than 27 cm in length."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the Gazette, amend the Fisheries (Auckland and Kermadec Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986.

Regulation 2 amends regulation 3A of the principal regulations and reduces the daily amateur bag limit for snapper in the Auckland and Kermadec Fishery Management Areas from 20 to 15 per person.

Regulation 3 inserts into the principal regulations new regulation 3c and increases from 25 cm to 27 cm the amateur minimum length for snapper in the Auckland and Kermadec Fishery Management Areas.
