PURSUANT to the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Foot and Mouth Disease Control Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Foot and Mouth Disease Control Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- Suspicion of foot and mouth disease near port or airport— Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "30 miles", and substituting the words "50 kilometres".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the principal regulations by converting a reference to 30 miles to a reference to 50 kilometres.
