

THE FOOD ADDITIVES NOTICE 1991

Pursuant to section 42 (2) of the Food Act 1981, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. **Title**—This notice may be cited as the Food Additives Notice 1991.
- 2. Duration of notice—This notice shall have effect for the period of 12 months commencing on the 1st day of February 1991.
- 3. Maximum permitted proportion of clethodim in vegetables— Notwithstanding anything in regulation 257 (2A) of the Food Regulations 1984* (as inserted by regulation 34(1) of the Food Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 2), vegetables may contain as an incidental constituent, in a proportion not exceeding 1 ppm, the pesticide clethodim.

This notice has effect for the period of 12 months commencing on 1 February 1991. During that period vegetables may contain the pesticide clethodim in a proportion not exceeding 1 part per million.
