ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 25th day of August 1975

THE RIGHT HON. W. E. ROWLING PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 100 of the Factories Act 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the First Aid (Factories) Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the First Aid (Factories) Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Metric amendments—(1) Regulation 13 (1) (a) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "100 sq. ft." and substituting the expression "10 m²".

(2) Each expression appearing in the First Schedule of the principal regulations set out in the first column of the Schedule to these regulations is hereby omitted wherever it appears and the expression opposite it in the second column of the Schedule to these regulations is hereby substituted for it in each case.

3. First aid requisites—The first column of the First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting the expression "Cetrimide 1 per cent*" and substituting the expression "Solution of 3 percent cetrimide and 0.3 percent chlorhexidine".

4. Savings—In relation to every first-aid room set aside or provided before the commencement of these regulations pursuant to regulation 12 of the principal regulations, and in relation to all first-aid appliances and requisites ordered or purchased by the occupier of a factory before the commencement of these regulations, the principal regulations shall be read as if these regulations had not been made.
