**THE FOREST AND RURAL FIRES REGULATIONS 1979,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 19th day of March 1979

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Forest and Rural Fires Regulations 1979, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Forest and Rural Fires Regulations 1979\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1979.

**2. Fire signs**—Regulation 37 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) Be in the form of an equilateral triangle, with the base side horizontal, and with each of the 3 sides one metre in length; and”
