Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2002.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 11 July 2002.

3 Revocation of spent provisions

Regulations 4, 5A, 5B, and 6A of the principal regulations are revoked.

4 Offences

Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subclause (1) the expression “5A, 5B,”;
- (b) by omitting from subclause (2) the expression “6A,”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 11 July 2002, amend the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986 by revoking certain spent regulations relating to trawling in Foveaux Strait and to female rock lobsters.
