PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 19, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas

Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1994.

**2. Interpretation**—Regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 11) is hereby amended by omitting from the definition of the term “oyster” the words “*Tiostrea lutaria*”, and substituting the words “*Tiostrea chilensis*”.

**3. Total prohibitions**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 3, and substituting the following regulation:

“3. No commercial fisherman shall take any fish from, or have in possession any fish taken from, the following waters:

“(a) The waters of Milford Sound and all those waters in the vicinity of Milford Sound lying inside a straight line drawn from St. Anne Point (at 44° 34.45’ S and 167° 47.16’ E) to Stripe Point (at 44° 32.37’ S and 167° 49.8’ E);

“(b) Those waters of Paterson Inlet lying inside a straight line drawn from Ackers Point (at 46° 53.85’ S and 168° 09.76’ E) to Bullers Point on Stewart Island (at 46° 55.26’ S and 168° 11.45’ E).”

(2) Regulation 2 of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 3 is hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1994, amend the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986.

*Regulation 2* updates the reference to the term "dredge oyster" in the definition of the term "oyster" in regulation 2 of the principal regulations.

*Regulation 3* revokes and replaces regulation 3 of the principal regulations. The principal change is to impose a total prohibition on commercial fishing in certain waters of Paterson Inlet.
