PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 21, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas

Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1996.

- 2. Concession relating to female rock lobster—(1) Regulation 5c (1) of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 6) is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a) (as amended by regulation 4 of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 18), and substituting the following paragraph:
 - "(a) The rock lobster is taken from the Southland Concession Area;

and".

(2) Regulation 4 of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 18 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations extend the current concession for the taking of female rock lobster in the Southland Fishery. The concession, which was otherwise due to expire on 31 March 1996, allows the taking of female rock lobster with a minimum tail width of 57mm, rather than the normal 60mm.
