HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1988.
- **2.** Interpretation—(1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a) of the definition of the term "length".

- (2) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking the definition of the term "measuring device".
- 3. Tailing at sea permitted in specified area—Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations make amendments to the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986 that are consequential upon the change to a tail width measurement for rock lobster effected by the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 2.
