ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their publication in the *Gazette*.

2. Oyster season and quotas—(1) Regulation 7 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Fisheries (Southland and

Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 2 and amended by regulation 4 of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 3) is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from subclause (2) the expression “92,000”, in both places where it occurs, and substituting in each case the expression “115,000”:

(b) By omitting from subclause (3) the expression “4,000”, and substituting the expression “5,000”.

(2) Regulation 7 of the principal regulations (as so substituted) is hereby further amended by inserting, after subclause (3), the following subclause: “(3A) No commercial fisherman shall, before the 1st day of June in any fishing year, use any fishing vessel to take any oyster from the Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery if the vessel has been used by that or any other commercial fisherman to take in that fishing year 3,250 or more sacks of oysters from that fishery before that date.”

3. Revocation—Regulation 4 of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 3 is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, change the controls in relation to the Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery by—

- (i) increasing the seasonal quota from 92,000 sacks to 115,000 sacks;
- (ii) increasing the individual boat quota from 4,000 sacks to 5,000 sacks; and
- (iii) imposing a limit of 3,250 sacks on the number of sacks that an individual vessel may take before 1 June in any fishing year.
