PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Oyster season and quotas—Regulation 7 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 4 (1) of the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 6) is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from subclause (2) the expression “92 000” in both places where it occurs, and substituting in each case the expression “46 000”;
- (b) By omitting from subclause (3) the expression “4 000”, and substituting the expression “2 000”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, alter the limits in relation to the Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery by—

- (i) reducing the seasonal limit from 92 000 to 46 000 sacks; and
- (ii) reducing the individual boat limit from 4 000 to 2 000 sacks.
