Pursuant to the Fees and Travelling Allowances Act 1951, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Fees and Travelling Allowances Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fees and Travelling Allowances Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Paragraph (a) of regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "in excess of 5s.", and substituting the words "in excess of such amount as the Minister from time to time approves".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide that the Minister of Finance may from time to time fix the amount of any disbursement above which members of statutory Boards claiming payment of certain allowances and expenses are required to submit vouchers.
