PURSUANT to the Fire Services Act 1972, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and application**—(1) This order may be cited as the Fire Board Chairmen (Annual Allowance) Order 1973.

(2) This order shall apply with respect to the financial year ending with the 31st day of March 1974 and every succeeding financial year.

**2. Annual allowance**—The annual allowances set out in the Schedule hereto in respect of the Fire Boards mentioned in that Schedule may be paid to the Chairmen of those Fire Boards in each financial year.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE
