A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection two of section one of the Family Benefits (Reciprocity with Northern Ireland) Act, 1948, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare as follows:—

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Family Benefits (Reciprocity with Northern Ireland) Act Commencement Order 1948.
2. The Family Benefits (Reciprocity with Northern Ireland) Act, 1948, shall come into force on the first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the Seal of that Dominion, this 26th day of November, 1948.
