## THE FITNESS CERTIFICATE (MOTOR-CAB) EXEMPTION ORDER, 1937.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: Section 27 of the Transport Law Amendment Act, 1933, and all other powers enabling in that behalf.

Date on which the regulations were made: 4th day of August, 1937. Date of notification in Gazette: 12th day of August, 1937.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Fitness Certificate (Motor-cab) Exemption Order, 1937.
- 2. Passenger-service vehicles of the class set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the requirements of section 38 of the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, as to a certificate of fitness being in force with respect to such vehicles while the same are used in connection with a passenger-service.

## SCHEDULE.

## CLASS OF EXEMPTED VEHICLES.

Any motor-vehicle which-

- (a) Is designed for the carriage of persons not exceeding eight in number,
- including the driver; and

  (b) Is available for hire to any member of the public on terms which do not require, expressly or impliedly, the payment of separate fares by each passenger; and
- (c) Is used for hire or reward for the carriage of passengers with or without goods and otherwise than on defined routes.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act, 1936. These regulations are administered by the Transport Department.
