## THE FRUIT CONTROL GENERAL REGULATIONS, 1937.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.
Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Fruit Control Act, 1924.

Date on which the regulations were made: 27th day of July, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 29th day of July, 1937.

## REGULATIONS.

- (1) These regulations may be cited as the Fruit Control General Regulations, 1937.
  - (2) In these regulations, unless inconsistent with the context,—
    - "The said Act" means the Fruit Control Act, 1924:
      "Board" means the New Zealand Fruit-export Control Board
    - "Board" means the New Zealand Fruit-export Control Board established by the said Act:
    - "Business of the Board" means attendance at any meeting of the Board or of any committee of the Board and any business transacted by a member of the Board pursuant to a resolution of the Board.
- (3) The respective regulations referred to in the Schedule hereto are revoked.
- 2. The maximum fees payable to members of the Board shall be a daily fee at the following rate:—

Chairman .. .. £125 per annum. Other members .. . £75 per annum.

Provided that when the Chairman or any other member is engaged on the business of the Board in New Zealand, other than that connected with ordinary Board meetings, the following additional fees shall be payable:—

 Chairman
 ...
 £2 2s. per diem.

 Other members
 ...
 £1 1s. per diem.

3. The maximum rate of travelling-allowance payable to members of the Board whilst travelling in New Zealand on the business of the Board shall be £1 per diem, plus actual locomotion expenses.

4. The maximum fee payable to any member of the Board whilst engaged beyond New Zealand on the business of the Board shall be a

daily fee at the rate of £1,000 per annum.

5. The maximum rate of travelling-allowance payable to any member of the Board whilst engaged beyond New Zealand on the business of the Board shall be £1 1s. per diem, plus actual locomotion expenses.

6. The charge payable by way of levy on all fruit produced in a district in which Part I of the said Act is for the time being in

operation and intended for export shall be  $2\frac{1}{4}$ d. per case.

7. Any moneys payable under Regulation 6 hereof shall be paid to the Board immediately upon the shipment of the fruit beyond New Zealand.
