PURSUANT to section 72 of the Forests Act 1949, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Forestry (East Coast) Grants Regulations 1992, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Forestry (East Coast) Grants Regulations 1992* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

Applications for approval certificates—Regulation 4 (2) (b) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subparagraph (iii), and substituting the following subparagraph:

"(iii) The tending regime to be carried out in respect of the planted area:".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Forestry (East Coast) Grants Regulations 1992.

The purpose of the amendment is to remove from regulation 4 of the principal regulations a requirement to submit a 10-year management regime when applying for an approval certificate. The requirement was appropriate for plantings of radiata pine but, with the inclusion of Douglas fir plantings in the scheme, it is no longer appropriate. In future, applicants will be required to submit the tending regime.
