THE FITNESS CERTIFICATE (SCHOOL MOTOR-CAR) EXEMPTION ORDER 1938.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 3rd day of August, 1938.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to section 27 of the Transport Law Amendment Act, 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Fitness Certificate (School Motorcar) Exemption Order 1938.
- 2. Passenger-service vehicles of the class set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the requirements of section 38 of the Transport Licensing Act, 1931, as to a certificate of fitness being in force with respect to such vehicles while the same are used in connection with a passenger-service.

SCHEDULE.

CLASS OF EXEMPTED VEHICLES.

ANY motor-car, as defined in section 2 of the Motor-vehicles Act, 1924, if in the carriage of passengers for hire or reward it is used solely for the transport of school-children not exceeding seven in number and not exceeding by more than two the designed adult passenger-carrying capacity of the motor-car.

For the purpose of this Schedule the word "passenger" does not include the driver.
