THE FOODSTUFFS (POTATOES) CONTROL NOTICE 1942

Pursuant to the Foodstuffs Emergency Regulations 1939,* I, James Ewing Thomas, Food Controller, hereby require and direct as follows:—

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Foodstuffs (Potatoes) Control Notice 1942.
- 2. This notice shall apply to all potatoes that are not seed potatoes within the meaning of the Sale of Potatoes Control Order 1942†.
- 3. No grower shall sell any potatoes to which this notice applies except to the Food Controller or his appointed agent.
- 4. No merchant or wholesaler shall sell or ship potatoes to which this notice applies except with the prior consent of, or in accordance with the directions of, the Food Controller.
- 5. Except with the prior consent of the Food Controller, no person shall ship potatoes from the North Island to the South Island or from the South Island to the North Island.
