



**THE FERTILIZER CONTROL ORDER 1942, AMENDMENT
NO. 1**

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Primary Industries Emergency Regulations 1939,* the Minister of Agriculture hereby makes the following Order.

ORDER.

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Fertilizer Control Order 1942, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fertilizer Control Order 1942† (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

(2) This Order shall come into force on the day following the date of publication in the *Gazette* of a notification of the making thereof.

2. (1) Except with the consent of the Controller, no person shall be entitled to acquire any phosphatic fertilizer in accordance with clause 8 or clause 10 of the principal Order, unless his application or order for such fertilizer is received by the vendor on or before the 5th day of May, 1943.

(2) It shall be the duty of every vendor of phosphatic fertilizer to forward to a manufacturing vendor, so as to reach him on or before the 10th day of May, 1943, all applications or orders for any such fertilizer that are received by the vendor on or before the 5th day of May, 1943.

(3) Except with the consent of the Controller, no manufacturing vendor shall fulfil any order for any phosphatic fertilizer as aforesaid that is received by him after the 10th day of May, 1943.
