**THE FERTILIZER CONTROL ORDER 1947,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Primary Industries Emergency Regulations 1939,* the Minister of Agriculture hereby makes the following Order.

O R D E R

1. This Order may be cited as the Fertilizer Control Order 1947, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fertilizer Control Order 1947† (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. This Order shall come into force on the 30th day of June, 1948.

3. The Fertilizer Control Order 1947, Amendment No. 1‡, is hereby revoked.

4. Clause 5 of the principal Order is hereby revoked, and the following clause substituted therefor:—

“ 5. This Order, in so far as it relates to the sale or purchase of fertilizers, applies with respect to the sale and purchase of fertilizers at any time after the commencement of this Order and before the 1st day of July, 1949.”

5. Subclause (2) of clause 8 of the principal Order is hereby amended by omitting the words “ 30th day of June, 1947 ”, and substituting the words “ 30th day of June, 1948 ”.
